Before the start of the procession:

- Plan your departure according to the itinerary and schedule of the procession you wish to see.
- Take public transport to the city centre.



During processions:

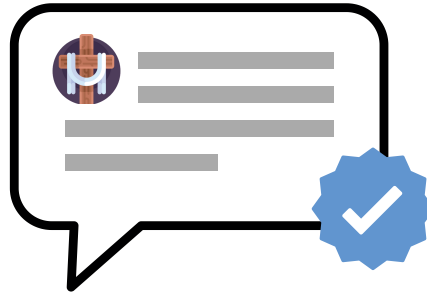
- Follow the instructions of security staff and organisers.

Be especially careful with children:

- Make sure they are wearing a QR wristband that you can request at the authorised Civil Protection points.

In the event of an emergency:

- Do not run or push.
- Follow the instructions of the emergency services.
- Use the marked evacuation routes.
- If you need help, call 112 or 092.



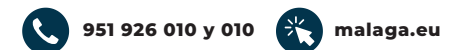
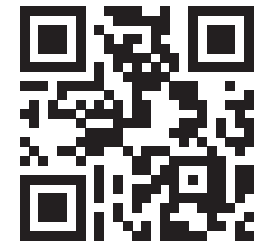
Is the information you get from social media this Easter and which you are forwarding to your contacts is true?
