Before the start of the procession:

- Plan your departure according to the route and schedule of the procession you wish to see.
- Take public transport to the city centre.



During processions:

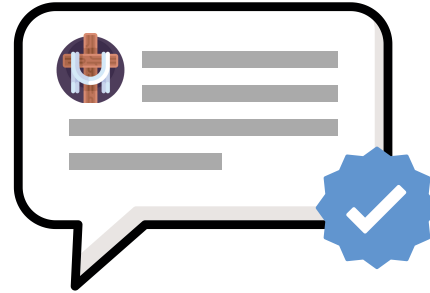
- Follow the instructions given by security staff and organisers.

Be especially careful with children:

- Make sure they are wearing a QR wristband that you can request at the authorised Civil Protection points.

In the event of an emergency:

- Do not run or push.
- Follow the instructions given by the emergency services.
- Use the marked evacuation routes.
- If you need help, call 112 or 092.



Are you forwarding accurate information from social media to your contacts about this Easter?

- ✓ Don't assume everything you read is true: make sure you check it carefully, there's a lot of fake news out there.
- ✓ Look at how it's written: fake news often contains misspellings.
- ✓ Check the dates and look up when and where it was published.

Do not listen to rumours or spread them. Only share properly verified information.

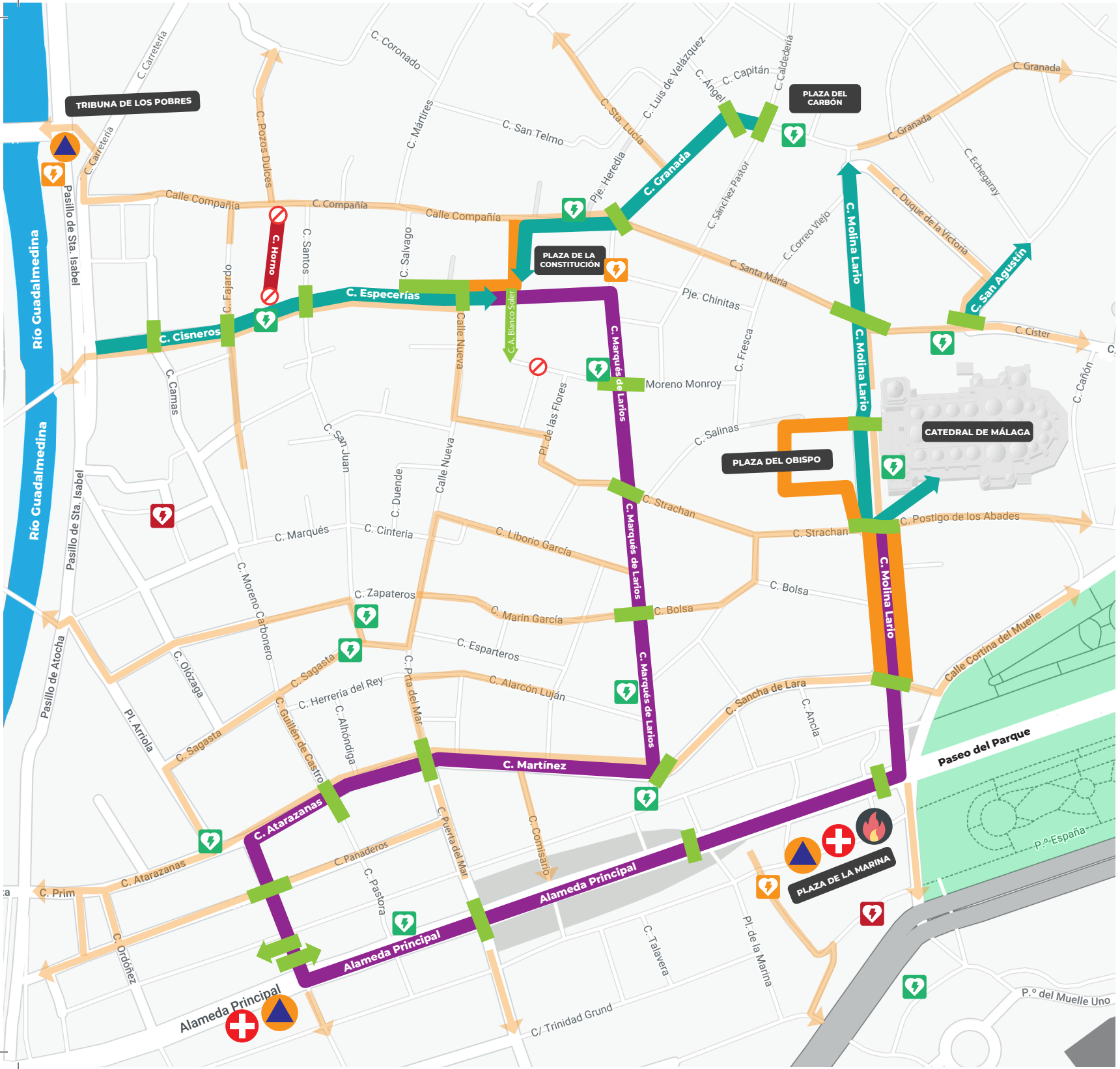
